### **ROMANS 3:9-12**

<sup>9</sup>What then? Are we Jews any better off? No, not at all. For we have already charged that all, both Jews and Greeks, are under sin, <sup>10</sup>as it is written: "None is righteous, no, not one; <sup>11</sup>no one understands; no one seeks for God. <sup>12</sup>All have turned aside; together they have become worthless; no one does good, not even one."

## **GOD'S WRATH**

- God's present releasing of people to do what they will.
- God's future separating of people from His presence.

### WHY?

#### Gentiles...created a god of their own choosing. (1:18–32) That would not challenge their morality.

#### Jews...created a righteousness of their own choosing. (2:1-3:8) That would not challenge their heart.

**RENEWAL:** Is the concept of God's wrath difficult for you to accept? Why or why not? How have we as a culture created gods of our own choosing? Share about a time you struggled with feelings of self-righteousness. Is it easy for you to ask for or accept help from others? Why or why not? At what point in your life did you most sense your need for help from an outside source? Do you believe you need more help than you think you do? **How is the Gospel Good News for you today?**
