## NO ICH MARK 5:21-42

<sup>21</sup>A large crowd gathered near Jesus by the Sea of Galilee. <sup>22</sup>Then Jairus, a leader of the local synagogue, arrived. Seeing Jesus, he fell at his feet <sup>23</sup>and pleaded fervently, "My little daughter is at the point of death. Come and lay your hands on her, so that she may be made well and live." <sup>24</sup>And he went with him. A large crowd followed closely.

<sup>25</sup>A woman in the crowd had struggled for 12 years from constant bleeding. <sup>26</sup>She had suffered much under many physicians. She had spent all that she had. She was no better. She only grew worse. <sup>27</sup>She had heard the reports about Jesus and came up behind him in the crowd and touched his clothes. <sup>28</sup>For she thought, "If I touch even his garments, I will be made well." <sup>29</sup>Immediately she stopped bleeding, and she sensed in her body that she was healed of her suffering. <sup>30</sup>And Jesus sensed that power had gone out from him. He immediately turned about in the crowd and said, "Who touched my clothes?" <sup>31</sup>His disciples said to him, "You see the crowd pressing around you, and yet you say 'Who touched me?'" <sup>32</sup>But Jesus looked around to see who had done it. <sup>33</sup>The woman, knowing what had happened to her, came in fear and trembling and fell at his feet and told him the whole truth. <sup>34</sup>And Jesus said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace. Your suffering is over."

<sup>35</sup>While he was still speaking, some people came from the house of Jairus the synagogue leader and said, "Your daughter is dead. Why bother the Teacher any futher?" <sup>36</sup>Overhearing what they said, Jesus said to Jairus, "Do not fear, only believe." <sup>37</sup>And Jesus allowed no one to follow him except Peter and James and John the brother of James. <sup>38</sup>They came to the home of the synagogue leader, and Jesus saw a commotion, people weeping and wailing loudly. <sup>39</sup>And when he had entered, he said to them, "Why are you making such a commotion and weeping? The child is not dead but sleeping." <sup>40</sup>They laughed at him. So he made them all leave and took the child's father and mother and those who were with him and went in where the child was. <sup>41</sup>Taking her by the hand Jesus said to her, "Little girl, I say to you, arise." <sup>42</sup>Immediately the girl who was twelve years old got up and began walking and they were immediately overcome with amazement.
