



2 Timothy 4:1-22: THE PRIZE

- 1 I solemnly charge [you] before God and Christ Jesus who is going to judge the living and the dead, and by His appearing and His kingdom:
- 2 preach the word; be ready in favorable time, in unfavorable time; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with all patience and teaching.

1. The C

- 3 For the time will come when they will not accept sound teaching; but, according to their own lusts, they will accumulate teachers for themselves, having itching ears;
- 4 and they will turn away their ears from the truth, but will turn aside to myths.
- 5 But you, be sober in all things, suffer affliction, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your service.
- 6 For I myself am already being poured out as an offering, and the time of my departure is at hand.
- 7 I have fought the good fight, I have completed the course, I have kept the faith;
- 8 in the future there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award [Grk. *apodidōmi*] to me on that day; and not only to me, but also to all who have loved His appearing.
- 9 Make every effort to come to me soon;
- 10 for Demas, having loved the present age, deserted me and went to Thessalonica, Crescens to Galatia, Titus to Dalmatia;
- 11 Luke alone is with me. Pick up Mark and bring him with you, for he is beneficial to me for service.
- 12 But Tychicus I have sent to Ephesus.
- 13 When you come, bring the cloak which I left in Troas with Carpus, and the scrolls, especially the parchments.
- 14 Alexander the coppersmith perpetrated much evil against me; the Lord will recompense [Grk. *apodidōmi*] him according to his work,

- 15 be on guard against him yourself, for he opposed our words.
- 16 At my first defense no one supported me, but all deserted me; may it not be counted against them.
- 17 But the Lord stood with me and strengthened me, so that through me the proclamation might be fulfilled and [that] all the Gentiles might hear; and I was delivered from the lion's mouth.
- 18 The Lord will deliver me from every evil work and will save [me] into His heavenly kingdom; to whom [be] the glory from eternity to eternity! Amen.
- 19 Greet Prisca and Aquila, and the household of Onesiphorus.
- 20 Erastus remained in Corinth, but Trophimus, being ill, I left in Miletus.
- 21 Make every effort to come before winter. Eubulus greets you and Pudens and Linus and Claudia and all the brothers and sisters.
- 22 The Lord be with your spirit. Grace be with you [all].
