

**Bible Passage:** Genesis 6-10

**CHRIST CONNECTION:** We can trust in Jesus.

**Key Passage:** We all make wrong choices. Romans 3:23

## CIRCLE TIME

### Circle time (5 minutes)

Provide small Bibles for toddlers to handle. Say the Bible is God's words. Read the key passage card. Open your Bible to Revelation 1. Show the Bible story picture as you tell the Bible story. Pray.

## BIBLE STORY

### Genesis 6-10

All people after Adam and Eve disobeyed God too. God was very sad. One day, God told Noah to make a big boat. Noah obeyed God. Then Noah, his family, and some of every animal got in the boat. Rain came and the earth was covered with water. The boat floated, and God kept Noah and his family safe. When the water went back down and everyone came out of the boat, Noah thanked God. God promised to never again flood the whole earth, and He put a rainbow in the sky to remind us of His promise.

## ACTIVITIES

Use these activities as you play and interact with toddlers while they are in your care.

### SING A BIBLE STORY SONG

Sing to the tune of "Mary Had a Little Lamb":

"Holy, holy is the Lord, is the Lord, is the Lord!

Holy, holy is the Lord! He alone is God."

*Say: God is holy. That means God always does what is right, and He never does what is wrong. The Bible tells us that everyone has sinned. God planned to send Jesus to make everything right.*

### Take a nature walk

Using a walking rope, take toddlers outside according to your church's security procedures. Point out the tallest trees or hills. Remind toddlers that water would have covered up even the tallest mountains in the world. Tell the Bible story and return to the room.

*Say: People did not want to obey God, so God covered the whole earth with water. God kept Noah's family safe inside the ark (big boat). Instead of sending more floods to punish sin, God sent Jesus because He loves us.*

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## CLOSING ACTIVITES

Before doing closing activities, please have the children help you clean up the toys and materials that have been used today. After the room is cleaned up, set out crayons and let children work on today's **Bible Story Coloring Page** until their parents arrive. You can also choose a book to read to the children as they color or for those who don't want to color. Please make the effort to have the children quietly engaged when parents arrive.

When parents arrive to pick up their children, tell them something that their child enjoyed doing or did well today.
