- is a constant choice.
- will be revealed.
- makes us or breaks us.

*Loyalty - showing up no matter what.

LOYALTY PRAYER

I am no longer my own but yours. Put me to what you will, connect me with whom you will; put me to doing, put me to suffering; let me be employed for you, or laid aside for you, exalted for you, or brought low for you; let me be full, let me be empty, let me have all things, let me have nothing: I freely and wholeheartedly yield all things to your pleasure and disposal. And now, glorious and blessed God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, you are mine and I am yours. So be it.
