

Bible Passage: Psalm 139

CHRIST CONNECTION: God made us and cares for us. He sent Jesus to save us from our sins.

Key Passage phrase: GOD MADE ME. PSALM 139:14

BIBLE STORY

King David wrote a song to God. David wrote, "Lord, you know me. You know everything I think about. You know everything about me. You made me. I will praise You because You made me. Everything You make and do is wonderful! You knew me before I was born. You knew what my life would be like. You planned out all my days." Finally, David prayed, "God, you know what I think and feel. See if I am doing wrong and lead me to live the way that is right."

ACTIVITIES

SING A HYMN

Sing the chorus of "Trust and Obey." If you are unfamiliar with the tune, look it up before the session.

"Trust and obey, for there's no other way
To be happy in Jesus, but to trust and obey."

SAY *God knows us, loves us, and He is always with us.*

DRAW WITH CHALK

Pass out black construction paper. Encourage children to trace their hands on the paper using chalk or construction paper crayons. Allow children to decorate their drawings. Print *God made me. Psalm 139:14* on each child's artwork. Keep baby wipes nearby for easy cleanup.

SAY: *Our artwork reminds us of the truth that God made us. He knows what you will do with your hands tomorrow and when you grow up. We can praise God because He made us and loves us!*

CLOSING ACTIVITES

Before doing closing activities, please have the children help you clean up the toys and materials that have been used today. After the room is cleaned up, set out crayons and let children work on today's **Bible Story Coloring Page** until their parents arrive. You can also choose a book to read to the children as they color or for those who don't want to color. Please make the effort to have the children quietly engaged when parents arrive. When parents arrive to pick up their children, tell them something that their child enjoyed doing or did well today.

BEFORE YOU GO...

Please clean up by doing the following:

- 1) Leave toys set up on tables so they can be sanitized.
- 2) Use surface spray to wipe down tables.
