HOW DO WE REMAIN LOYAL TO GOD?

## I. REFLECT ON GOD'S AFFECTIONS FOR YOU.

Reflecting leads to responding.

- a. God knows you personally (vs 1-6)
- b. God is always with you (vs 7-12)
- c. God created you intentionally (vs 13-16)

## II. WE RESPOND IN LOYALTY TO GOD'S AFFECTIONS FOR US.

Here's our response:

Search me, try me, see me, lead me.

**RENEWAL QUESTIONS:** Where are you desperately dependent on Jesus? How is loyalty regarded in our society? What or who has your loyalty? What might others say you are loyal to? Reflect on God's affections for you: God knows you personally, God is always with you, and God created you intentionally. How does reflecting on God's affections for us impact our faith? Reflection leads to response. What are some ways we may respond in loyalty to God's affections for us? How might this impact us in our daily lives? This week, how and when will you reflect on God's affections for you? How will you respond in loyalty to God, asking that he search you, try you, see you, and lead you?
