- ³ "Let us tear away their fetters, and let us throw off from us their ropes!"
- ⁴ He who sits in the heavens laughs; the Lord mocks them.
- ⁵ Then He will speak to them in His anger, and in His fury terrify them.
- ⁶ "But I myself have installed My King upon Zion, My holy mountain."
- ⁷ "I shall tell of the decree of Yahweh: He said to Me, 'You are My Son [Hebrew: bēn]; today I myself have begotten You.
- ⁸ Ask of Me, and I will give the nations as Your inheritance, and as Your possession, the ends of the earth.
- 9 You will break them with a rod of iron, like a vessel of a potter You will shatter them.'
- ¹⁰ So now, kings, be sensible; be warned, judges of the earth.
- 11 Serve Yahweh with fear, and rejoice with trembling.
- ¹² Do homage to the Son [Aramaic: $b\bar{a}r$], that He not be angry, and you perish [with regard to the] path, for His anger may soon blaze. Blessed are all who seek refuge in Him!
