RENEWAL QUESTIONS: How does our culture view sin? How does the traditional understanding of this word fit (or not fit) within our culture? To be unteachable is to lack curiosity, humility, and a genuine desire for dependence on God. How does an unteachable heart impact our relationship with God and with others? The sin in Cain's heart was initially undetectable so he was unteachable and therefore unrepentant, and so his sin was unrelenting. Which characteristic of sin in Cain's life stands out the most to you? How does it influence the relationship between God and Cain? Before we can address our sin or hope to change anything—our hearts must first be melted by the loving kindness of God. Why must that happen first and foremost? This week, how will you engage with God and remind yourself of his loving kindness? How and when will you seek to address areas of sin in your life?
