RENEWAL QUESTIONS: In 2 Timothy 3:1-9, Paul shares characteristics of people in the church who will pose a threat to the next generation. Which of these characteristics stand out to you the most, and why? Ultimately, Paul's condemnation of this foolish generation is really a condemnation of the heart. How might misdirecting our affections lead us to be lovers of self rather than lovers of God? How does faithful generational modeling, like the faith Paul modeled for Timothy, impact us as believers? How does it influence future faith generations? Paul shares one command with Timothy what is it? Why is this practice critical for us as Christ followers? This week, spend some time in God's Word consistently. Each time, pray, "God, I accept these words from your mouth." When will you plan to spend time reading your Bible, and where do you plan to start?
