1 CORINTHIANS 7:6-9, 25-35

## THREE TRUTHS ABOUT SINGLENESS

TRUTH 1: Singleness is a gift from God.

TRUTH 2: Singleness has divine purpose.

TRUTH 3: Singleness is a promise of something greater to come

**RENEWAL QUESTIONS:** How is singleness typically portrayed in our society? How is singleness typically portrayed or referenced within the church? Over time, what impact might these narratives have on us? Pain abounds when we look for fulfillment in someone, anyone, other than Jesus. How can we avoid falling into this line of thinking? How can we support one another to focus first on Jesus, regardless of our marital status? Read 1 Corinthians 7. What is Paul's attitude towards those who are single? How does Paul's message compare or contrast to what you have heard taught about singleness in the past? Read John 13:34-35. What calling has Jesus Christ placed on all believers? How might such a calling translate into how we speak about singleness, and how we engage with fellow believers who are single? This week, prayerfully consider how you might build relationships with those in a different life stage than you, because we are better together.
