**RENEWAL QUESTIONS:** Following Jesus requires a long obedience in the same direction. What does this mean for believers? What do you observe about the Israelites throughout Judges 1:1-2:2? How do they allow their circumstances to influence their obedience to God? The Israelites chose to compromise in their obedience to God, and ultimately this led to catastrophe. What can we learn from them? Why might disobedience to God lead to catastrophe? Your uncompromising obedience to God matters. What consequences did the Israelites face because of their disobedience (Judges 2:3)? How did they respond? This week, consider an area of your heart where you want to cultivate deeper obedience to the Lord. Consider, how might I obey God more? How can I invite others into this with me, as we follow Jesus and strive for long obedience in the same direction?
