RENEWAL QUESTIONS: Why is Peter's confession about Jesus' identity so significant? In Luke 9:21–22, Jesus foretells His death. What stands out to you in these verses? In Luke 9:18-36, we see themes of glory and death intertwined. How are glory and death related in this passage? What does this mean for believers in Christ? Jesus calls us to deny ourselves and take up our cross daily. Doing so might mean putting to death sin, comfort, resources, and/or being liked by all. Which of these seems the most challenging for you? Which is most countercultural? This week, consider whether you are putting God's glory ahead of your plans or personal comfort. What changes might you need to make this week to deny yourself and give God the glory in all you do?
