RENEWAL QUESTIONS: As believers, why should we go out and have conversations about Jesus? In Luke 11:14-16, Jesus performs a miracle and a man who was mute, speaks! How do those who witness the miracle respond? The revelation of Jesus' person and work produces conflict AND the natural state of a person is to not believe in Jesus. How do these two statements offer us courage and/or compassion? Jesus makes no space for neutrality about himself. What does this mean for us as believers? What does it mean for how we ought to approach having conversations about Jesus? This week, when and where will you seek to go out and have conversations about Jesus with courage and compassion?
