RENEWAL QUESTIONS: In Luke 15, we have three parables of Jesus that depict someone eagerly searching for something that is lost. What does this same element repeated in three different parables tell us about the heart of God towards sinners like us? What encouragement can we take from that? • In the parable of the prodigal son, there is the wayward and rebellious son who feels unworthy of his father's love or the hard-working achiever son who tries to earn his father's love. Is there one of the two sons with whom you more closely identify? • It is easy to find yourself surrounded by people who think, act and believe just like you do which makes it harder to find opportunities to have conversations about Jesus. When we reflect on what these parables tell us about how deep the father's love is for sinners who are far from him, what should our response be to that as followers of Jesus?
