- ARE ATTRACTED TO SUCCESS.
- DON'T HAVE GOD AS THEIR STANDARD OF GOOD.
- ASSUME GOD IS ON THEIR SIDE.
- DON'T THINK THEY HAVE ANYTHING TO REPENT OF.
- DON'T CONFESS MUCH.
- TRUST IN SOMETHING OTHER THAN GOD ALONE.
- DON'T THINK THEY NEED A MIRACLE FOR SALVATION.
- DON'T THINK SPIRITUAL REVIVAL IS SOLELY GOD'S WORK.
