RENEWAL QUESTIONS: Why do we attribute the prophecy in Micah 5 to Jesus? What are some of the reasons it matters that Jesus was born in Bethlehem? What circumstances had to come together so that this prophecy would be fulfilled? There is no place, whether physical or metaphorical, that is too insignificant for God to fulfill his promises. What does this mean for believers in Jesus? We all have a hard 'place' in our life that others may not know about. What is your 'place' right now? Where are you celebrating or where are you yearning for change or healing? This week, consider, how do we keep expecting God to fulfill his promises?
