MEMORY VERSE

PREPARE



Take time to reflect
on today's lesson.

LEADER BIBLE STUDY

God made you, and He made you special!

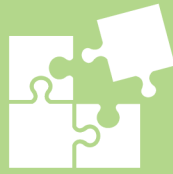
Luke 12:7 (NIV) says, “Indeed, the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Don’t be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows.” God made us to enjoy fellowship with others, and He wants us to have fellowship with Him.

We’re praying that this week’s lesson reminds you of all these things. Remember that you are made in His image and for a purpose. Teach this to your children this week. Pray that God shows you that purpose and that you rest in the value that He has in you. Do not isolate. Meet with a friend and fulfill the purpose of fellowship that has been revealed to us. Spend time with Him daily. He loves you and wants to be with you!

This week’s lesson is all about the special relationship God intended for us to have with Him. We were designed for fellowship—first with God and then with others. As you read through Genesis 2, notice how intentional God was in creating Adam and Eve. He thought of them and their needs and provided purpose for them from the very beginning. And He’s still doing that for us today!

Take time to reflect on what God has called you to, and thank Him for sending Jesus so we can be in right relationship with Him. Pray that each of our children would have a relationship with Jesus that would change their lives forever.

WELCOME & OPENING



Connect with children as service starts.

WELCOME

Play music through the undercabinet radio (flash drive), or connect your phone to Bluetooth through the radio and play Christian preschool/Bible songs as you greet children coming into the classroom. Help them transition in and feel welcome as they play games and interact with others.

THE LORD’S PRAYER/TEN COMMANDMENTS

Toddlers & Twos: Use the provided poster to review the Lord’s Prayer with the children in your class.

Threes & Fours: Using the provided poster, review the Ten Commandments with the children in your class. Read through each one, then have children repeat after you as you say them together.

CRAFT



Help children with a craft connected to the lesson.

CRAFT: PAPER APPLE

Give each child a paper apple template, red and green paper squares, and a glue stick. Help children decorate their apple template by gluing the pieces of red and green paper to the apple.

As you work, review the Bible lesson as a class.





BABIES & TWOS BIBLE LESSON

God saved the best creation for last! After He created everything by just speaking, He formed people from the dust of the ground.

After He formed Adam, the first man, He breathed life into him. Then He formed Adam a helper, the first woman, named Eve. God breathed life into her too. He placed them in a beautiful garden. God loved to walk and talk with them in the garden.

THREES & FOURS BIBLE LESSON

Last week we heard just a little bit about how God created people, so this week, we're going to talk about how God made people really special. The Bible says that God formed a man from the dust of the ground and breathed life into his nostrils! He called the man Adam.

Adam's job was to take great care of all the things God made. God also gave Adam a job to name all of the animals. But Adam was alone, and God saw that that was not good. So God caused Adam to fall into a deep sleep. While Adam slept, God took out one of his ribs. God used Adam's rib to create a woman. Her name was Eve. Eve was Adam's helper.

God gave Adam and Eve a beautiful garden to live in called the Garden of Eden, and the Bible said they enjoyed a relationship with God and with each other. That means that they were friends with each other, and even more special, they were friends with God! They loved to walk and talk with God in the garden.

The amazing thing is that we can all be friends with God, too. God sent His son Jesus to die on the cross so that we could always be friends with God.

SNACK & CLOSING



Continue to engage children near the end of the morning.

SNACK & DISCUSSION

Have everyone wash their hands, then serve a snack. Ask the following questions and retell parts of the lesson as needed.

1. What was your favorite part of today's Bible lesson?
2. What did you learn about God in today's Bible lesson?
3. Who did God create on the sixth day?
4. Who created all people? **God!**

CLOSING ACTIVITIES

Sing the clean up song. Have children help put toys on tables.

Gather them on the rug in a circle and have one volunteer read today's Bible lesson from the children's Bible. Have a regular Bible ready as well.

Sing the "B.I.B.L.E." and "Everything in the Bible is Absolutely True" songs. Remind children that the Bible is God's Word and the most important book in the whole world!

The other volunteer should stand at the door and help with pick up, matching stickers, gathering children's things, etc.
