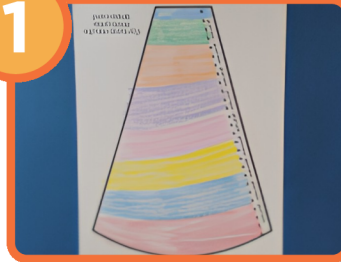


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What you need:

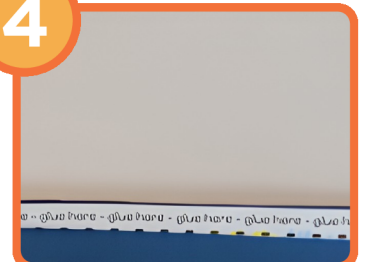

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Color the template.
